# Two Color Quilt Jewel Box 



Fabric Requirements:
White: (1) 7 " squares,
(4) 3.5 " squares.

Green: (1) 7" squares,
(4) 3.5 " squares.

- Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.


## Jewel Box Block (12.5" Unfinished)

1. Begin by making two four-patch blocks using the 3.5 " squares of each color as shown. Start by sewing together two squares of opposite colors (make four pair). Then sew two pair together to make the block. Each four-patch block should measure 6.5".

2. Next, make two half-square triangles (HSTs) using the 7" white and green squares. Draw a line corner to corner on the back of your 7" white square and place it right sides together with the 7 " green square. Sew $1 / 4 "$ on either side of the drawn line. Cut them apart on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric, creating 2 HSTs, and trim to 6.5 " square.

3. Now assemble your block with the units made in steps 1 and 2 , as shown. Your block should measure 12.5 " square.
