
Two Color Quilt Jewel Box



Fabric Requirements:

White: (1) 7" squares,

(4) 3.5" squares.


Green: (1) 7" squares,

(4) 3.5" squares.


• Use a ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.

Jewel Box Block (12.5" Unfinished)

1. Begin by making two four-patch blocks using the 3.5" squares of each color as shown. Start by sewing together two squares of opposite colors (make four pair). Then sew two pair together to make the block. Each four-patch block should measure 6.5".



2. Next, make two half-square triangles (HSTs) using the 7" white and green squares. Draw a line corner to corner on the back of your 7" white square and place it right sides together with the 7" green square. Sew ¼" on either side of the drawn line. Cut them apart on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric, creating 2 HSTs, and trim to 6.5" square.



3. Now assemble your block with the units made in steps 1 and 2, as shown. Your block should measure 12.5" square.
