# Two Color Quilt <br> <br> Sparkling Star 

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## Fabric Requirements:

White: (5) 5.5 " squares,
(4) 3.5 " squares,
(12) 2" squares.

Blue: (5) 5.5 " squares.

- Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.


## Sparkling Star Block (12.5" Unfinished)

1. Begin by making 36 Half Square Triangles (HSTs) with the eight-at-a-time method using the 5.5 " blue and white squares. Place a 5.5 " blue square on top of the white square with right sides together, then draw a line corner to corner on both diagonals. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of the drawn line. Cut squares apart horizontally and vertically, then on the diagonals to yield 8 HSTs. Repeat with each pair of blue and white squares. Trim all 2" square. You will have 4 extra HSTs.

2. Next, make 12 HST units as shown using the 2 " white squares. These should measure 3.5 " square.

3. Now assemble your block with the units made in step 2 and the 3.5 " white squares as shown. Your block should measure 12.5 " square.
