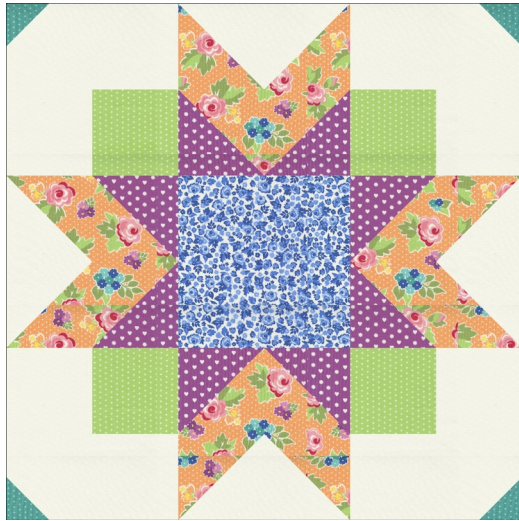


All Star Quilt Along-Week 10



Fabric Requirements(Per Block)

Background (Cream): (12) 2.5" squares,
(4) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles.

Accent Color (Teal): (4) 1.5" squares.

Lime Green: (4) 2.5" squares.

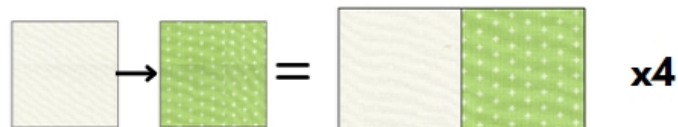
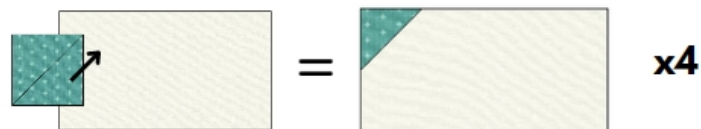
Blue (Center): (1) 4.5" square.

Purple: (8) 2.5" squares.

Orange: (8) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles.

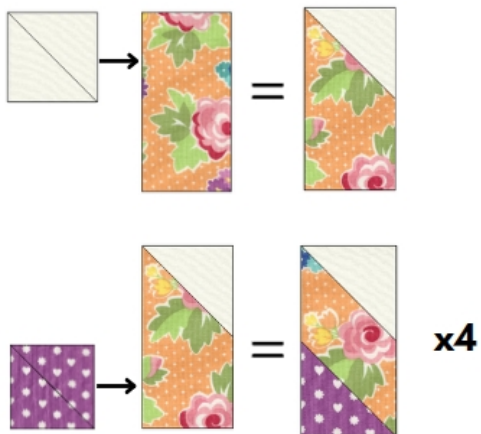
Prairie Star

1. First, make the four outside corner units. Begin by adding the accent teal squares (1.5") to the 2.5" x 4.5" background rectangles as shown. Then make two-patch units using (4) of the 2.5" background squares and the green 2.5" squares. Sew the two different units together as shown to make the four corner units of the block.

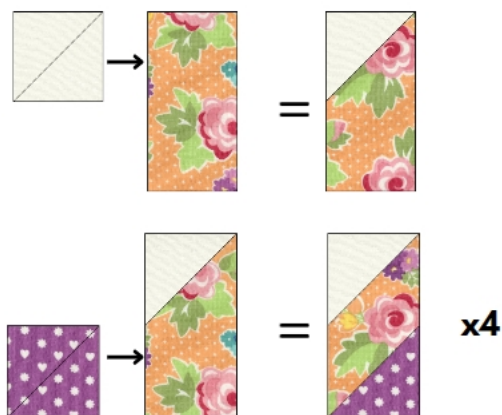


2. Next, using the (8) 2.5" x 4.5" orange rectangles, (8) 2.5" purple squares, and (8) 2.5" background squares, make the star leg units as shown below. Pay attention to fabric placement as there are four left and four right pieces that mirror each other. Sew together a left and right unit to make a star leg. Make four star leg units.

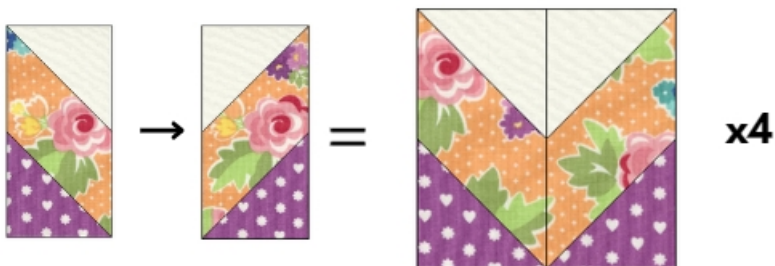

3. Now, assemble the block as shown. Don't forget to make two of these stars. Use different fabrics for each block for more variety. Block should measure 12.5" unfinished.
