All Star Quilt Along-Week 2




Helpful Hints:


- Iron your fabrics before cutting for more precise blocks.
- Use a ¹/₄" seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.

Friendship Star

1. Begin by adding your four accent 1.5" squares to the corners of the four 4.5" backgrounds squares as shown. Be sure to trim away the excess fabric and press out towards the corners. Set aside the four corner units for later.



2. Next, make four half-square triangles (HSTs) using the (2) 5.5" background squares and the (2) 5.5" purple squares. Draw a line corner to corner on the back of your 5.5" background squares and place them right sides together with the 5.5" purple squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the drawn line. Cut them apart on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric, creating 2 HSTs, and trim to 4.5" square. Make four HSTs per block.



3. Now assemble your block with the units made in steps 1 and 2, and with your remaining 4.5" square (color 1). Your block should measure 12.5" square. Make a second block using different colors.
