## AllStar Quillfflong-Week 4



## Fabric Requirements(Per Block)

Background (Cream): (4) 3.5" squares, (2) 4.5 " squares, (1) 5 " square,
(4) 3.5 " x 6.5 " rectangles.

Color 1 (Pink): (8) 3.5" squares.
Color 2 (Green Floral): (1) 5" square.
Accent Color (Teal): (4) 1.5 " squares.
Helpful Hints:

- Iron your fabrics before cutting for more precise blocks.
- Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.


## Sawtooth Twister Star

1. Begin by adding your four accent 1.5 " squares to the corners of the four 3.5 " backgrounds squares as shown. Be sure to trim away the excess fabric and press out towards the corners. Set aside the 4 corner units for later.

2. Next, make four flying geese units with the (4) 3.5 " $\times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles and the (8) $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ pink squares. Draw a line corner to corner on the back of the pink squares. Sew on the drawn line, beginning on the left side. Trim $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn line, and press. Repeat process on the right side, trim, press, and set aside for later.

3. Now, make four split quarter square triangle units. Begin by cutting the (2) 4.5 " background squares apart corner to corner to make four background triangles. Then cut the 5 " background and 5 " green floral square in quarters by cutting corner to corner in both directions. Then sew the print triangles and small background triangles as shown. Press towards the print ( $x 4$ ). Then join the large background triangle to the print/background triangle. Trim the split quarter square triangle to 3.5 " square. Make 4.


4. Last assemble the block as shown. Don't forget to make two of these stars. Use different fabrics for each block for more variety. Block should measure 12.5" unfinished.
