## All Star Quilt Along-Week 8



## Fabric Requirements(Per Block)

Accent color (teal):(4) 1.5" squares.
Background:(4) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles, (12) $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Yellow: (4) 2.5" squares. Purple: (4) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

Red: (4) 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles.
*Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance for piecing.

## Ribbon Star

1. Begin with the $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ accent squares and the background rectangles. Add a square to the upper left corner of each rectangle, sewing corner to corner. Trim and press to make four units as shown. Then using (4) 2.5" background squares and (4) $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ yellow squares, make 4 two-patch units. Press towards the yellow square. Join the two-patch and the rectangle units together to make the four corner units of the block.

2. Next add a 2.5" background square to the upper right corner of a purple $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make four. Then add a $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ background square to the upper left corner of a red $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make four.

3. Now sew together the corner units made in step 1 to the purple rectangle as shown. Then join the red rectangle to this unit. Make four.

4. Assemble block as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 12.5" unfinished. Make two blocks.
